SOUTH INDIA WILDLIFE TOUR

The Tiger is India's most famous feline. This is a tour where your senses are honed to be constantly on the alert to the sounds, sights and smells of nature. DAY 2: COCHIN-PERiyAR

After your breakfast, you will take the colourful roads and highways of Kerala. Soon you will reach the Western ghats. Driving through plantations of rubber, tea, coffee, and you will also get the whiff of the spices that grow abundantly while climbing the Western Ghats to an altitude of 900 meters above sea level. At Periyar you will check-in at your eco-friendly organic hotel. We will have a plan ready for you to visit the Periyar tiger reserve to suit your needs. We advise you to walk through a spice plantation and the hotel to familiarise yourself with the vegetation of this region.

DAY 3: PERiyAR

We will customise your activities according to your wishes; our activities include a walk in the spice plantations, bamboo rafting on the river, elephant walk in the plantations.

The full day Bamboo Raft comprising a trek and bamboo raft is fantastic with a lot of sightings especially on the return. Animals commonly seen in this region are Elephants, Gaur (Indian bison), Samba (deer), Malabar Giant Squirrel, Bonnet Macaque, Nilgiri Langoor.

More rarely sighted wild animals are Dole (Indian wild dog), Leopard, Tiger, and Sloth Bear.

You will be driving back to Cochin and stay overnight at the hotel. You will be taking a train in the morning to go to a natural paradise!

DAY 5: COCHIN- CALICUT-WAYANAD

You will take an early morning train to the bustling city of Calicut. From there you will take the car and go up the Western Ghats to an altitude of about 1000 meters and walk around on the fringes of a large wild life reserve. Here you will be checked into a resort that as they say is “nature’s home ground!” It is a relaxing ambience whose tranquillity is broken only by nature’s birds and the call of crickets.

The Nagarhole National Park has a rich forest cover, waterfalls and covers over 600kms².
