ARRIVAL IN DELHI

Exploring the blend of old and new can be a fascinating and rewarding experience. Old Delhi still contains legacies of its rich Mughal past that can be found among the old city's tangle of snaking lanes and teeming bazaars. Whereas New Delhi is completely different with lifestyle and city's architecture having the influence of British Rule in India.

AGRA

Located at the banks of River Yamuna, Agra offers the richest of the man-made beauties including three UNESCO World Heritage Sites – Agra forts, Fatehpur Sikhri and Taj Mahal. It is the haven of Mughal art, culture and architecture.

JAIPUR

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Jaipur, Capital of Rajasthan (India) is also known as the Pink City because of its pink coloured buildings in the walled city. The city is famous for its beautiful jewelry, fabrics, shoes also known as mojari, specious gardens and various historical monuments. Jaipur city with its romantic charm takes you to an epoch of royalty and tradition.

JODHPUR

Jodhpur, is the second largest city in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is located 335 kilometres west from the state capital, Jaipur and 200 kilometres from the city of Ajmer.

UDAIPUR

Udaipur, also known as the City of Lakes. Udaipur was founded in 1559 by Maharana Udai Singh II as the final capital of the erstwhile **Mewar** kingdom, located to the southwest of **Nagda**, on the **Banas River**, the first capital of the Mewar kingdom. Legend has it that **Maharana Udai Singh II** came upon a hermit while hunting in the foothills of the **Aravalli Range**. The hermit blessed the king and asked him to build a palace on the spot, assuring him it would be well protected. Udai Singh II consequently established a residence on the site. In 1568, the **Mughal** emperor **Akbar** captured the fort of **Chittor**, and Udai Singh moved the capital to the site of his residence, which became the city of Udaipur.

COCHIN

Kochi (colonial name Cochin) is a vibrant city situated on the south-west coast of the Indian peninsula in the breathtakingly scenic and prosperous state of Kerala, hailed as 'God's Own Country'. Its strategic importance over the centuries is underlined by the sobriquet Queen of the Arabian Sea. Informally, Cochin is also referred to as the Gateway to Kerala.

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MARARI

Marari Beach is a beach in Alappuzha District of Kerala, India. Barely 11 km from Alappuzha town, this sleepy little village, is an idyllic location for a vacation.

MUMBAI

Mumbai, formerly known as Bombay, is the capital city of the Indian state of Maharashtra. It is the most populous city in India, and the fourth most populous city in the world, with a total metropolitan area population of approximately 20.5 million.

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival in Delhi. India is changing. And India is changing fast. 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DAY 2

Discovery of these lines gives you a deeper understanding of the long standing 1000 year old history of this incredible city. It is a city richer in culture than what you have been made to believe so far. And to discover this, you need to take the customised tours arranged by our team.

Visits: Walled City, **Jama Masjid**, **Presidential House**, **India Gate**, Parliament and other Government Buildings, **Humayun's Tomb** and the **Qutb Minar**.

DAY 3: DELHI – AGRA

Morning, drive to Taj City – Agra in your exclusive vehicle. On arrival check-in to your Hotel and move out to visit **The Agra Fort** – the rusty and majestic red-sandstone fort of Agra stands on the banks of the river Yamuna and the construction was started by Emperor Akbar in 1566. Later at sunset visit the magnificent **Taj Mahal**– one of the seven wonders of the world surely the most extravagant expression of love ever created. It took over 17 years to build this memorial by Shah Jahan for his beloved wife Mumtaz. Night stay in your hotel.

Stay: The Oberoi Amarvilas

DAY 4: AGRA – JAIPUR

In the morning drive to Jaipur en-route visiting Fatehpur Sikri – a perfectly preserved red sandstone “ghost town” which was the estranged capital of Mughal emperor Akbar. On your arrival to the charming Pink City of India check-in at your hotel.

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This is the only city in the world symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe through the nine rectangular sectors subdividing it. In the evening if it takes your fancy, go for a walking tour of the colourful streets and bazaars of Jaipur City. The beauty of Jaipur is that its unique architecture and town planning is visible at even the most common places such as its squares and lanes.

Stay: Rambagh Palace

DAY 5: JAIPUR

Take a full day long sightseeing tour of Jaipur city that includes the excursion to the old capital Amber Fort, City Palace, Jantar Mantar observatory, façade of the Hawa Mahal. At Amber, you'll ascend till the gates of majestic fort on elephant back. The fort displays a beautiful mix of Mughal and Rajput styles of architecture.

DAY 6 : JAIPUR – JODHPUR

After breakfast proceed for Jodhpur. An amazing medieval city with a fort carved on top of a hill made of red sandstone. The city does not seem to move out of its time zone from 6 centuries ago. Go out for a sightseeing tour of the city. Visit the grandeur of the Mehrangarh fort.

Night stay at your hotel: Ummaid Bhawan Palace

DAY 7 : JODHPUR – RANAKPUR – UDAIPUR

Morning drive to Udaipur in your exclusive vehicle on the way Visit of Famous Jain Temple at Ranakpur.

Upon Arrival in Udaipur check-in at your hotel "The city is built in 1559 A.D. by Maharaja Udai Singh and has been described as the most romantic spot on the continent of India by Col. James Todd" In the evening take a walk through the colourful Bazaar.

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Night stay at hotel: Taj Lake Palace

DAY 8 : UDAIPUR

Take a full day sightseeing trip of the city which includes visit to the City Palace – the largest Palace museum of Rajasthan (note the trees growing at the top floor of the palace, which is actually the summit of the hill the palace is covering!), Saheliyon ki bari, luxuriate some time in this embellishing garden where royal ladies use to bask in the green lawns. Visit local school of miniature paintings.

PM Boat Ride on Lake Pichola and alight on the Jagmandir Island amidst the lake, the picturesque beauty of the palace will take your breath away.

Night stay at hotel: Taj Lake Palace

DAY 9 : UDAIPUR / BOMBAY / COCHIN

After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Cochin via Bombay. You would be met upon arrival in Cochin. A picturesque island cluster, natural ports and scenic lagoons, Cochin drapes you in warmth and ethnic Kerala glory. A glorious past and scenic greens make Cochin a splendid tour option. Remaining day at leisure. Overnight in your hotel.

Stay: Brunton Boatyard

DAY 10 : COCHIN

After having a leisurely breakfast, move out for sightseeing of Cochin which includes Fort Cochin, Dutch Palace, St. Francis church which is the oldest European Church in India, Jewish Synagogue and Famous Chinese fishing nets. In the evening, enjoy the famous dance drama of Kerala – **“The Kathakali”**. Overnight in your hotel.

Today drive down to Mararikulam-a host to numerous soft sand beaches.
